We empower National Programs to make **data-driven decisions** for program improvements through technical assistance

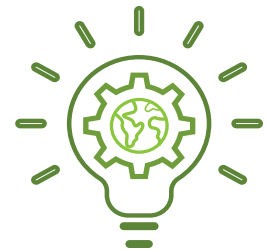


### Partnerships & Advocacy
